**GRADE AND AGE LEVELS**

All class grade levels refer to the grade the student will be entering in the fall of 2009. For 4 year olds, the student must be 4 years of age by June 1, 2009.

**LUNCH**

Students should bring a complete sack lunch, including a beverage. Lunch will be supervised. Since some students are deathly allergic to peanuts, please do not include peanut products in children's lunches.

**BEHAVIOR**

Students are expected to have good behavior and follow classroom and school rules at all times. Attendance at our summer program is a privilege, and inappropriate behavior may jeopardize that privilege.

**REFUNDS**

Due to our small class sizes, fees are not refundable. Refunds will be given, however, for any classes which are cancelled because minimum enrollment is not met.

**LATE PICK-UP**

Pickup is from 3:00 to 3:10 p.m. Any child not picked up by 3:15 p.m. will be sent to the Extended Day Program and charged the hourly rate, with a minimum of \$15.

**UNIVERSITY SCHOOL STUDENT FEES**

Two weeks of Camp Incredible 2009 are included in tuition for University School students (ages 4 and above) who are enrolled for the 2009-2010 academic year. These students must be registered for their two Camp Incredible weeks before May 15, 2009. Any registrations for the two included weeks received after this date will be subject to a \$25 per class fee.

**3A - Messy Masterpieces and Mini Mozarts***4 yrs old - 1st Grade***Instructor: Gloria Widdoes**

Campers will recreate famous works of art from such artists as Matisse, Picasso, and Monet as well as creating some original masterpieces of their own using different media and techniques. Art and music will go hand in hand when students learn how easy it is to make their own musical instruments.
